

The following is the guide as of July 2002:

NCS - This is net control (give your callsign), opening the Crow River Area Amateur Radio Net. This is a directed net. This net is held every Wednesday evening at 2100 Hrs local time. To Practice communications in the event this repeater and its participants are involved in emergency or public service communications.

Pause,,,,,,,,;

NCS - Please pause between communications exchanges to allow break-ins. If the repeater is not working, use 146.52 MHz or a frequency directed by net control.

Pause,,,,,,,,;

NCS - This net recognizes all Emergency, Priority, Welfare, Routine traffic. Are there any stations on frequency with any traffic?

(If any traffic, NCS calls for any stations that could handle or help with having the traffic being delivered)

Pause,,,,,,,,;

NCS - Net Control will now take check-ins, please give your callsign, name and location.

Pause,,,,,,,,; (record the stations checking in)

NCS - Net control acknowledges the following stations.

Go through the list of stations that have checked in. After the first list, check for more stations wanting to check in. Make sure every station gets to comment. After everyone has had a chance, make sure no one is left and or check for additional comments.

NCS - With no further comments or questions or traffic, net control will now close the Crow River Area Amateur Radio Net, there were (give the number of check ins). Thank you all for checking in, 73's, this is (your callsign) returning the repeater back to normal use.
